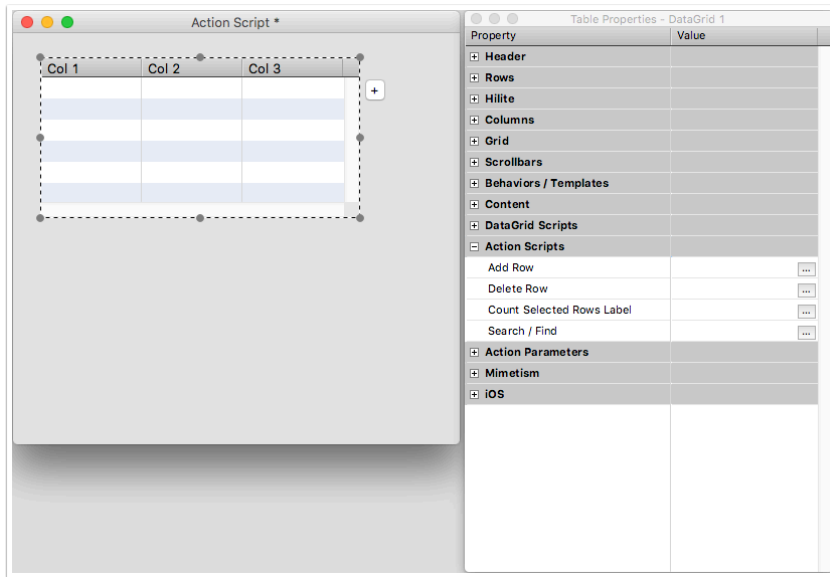


How Do I Define A Button To Be Used As An Action Script?

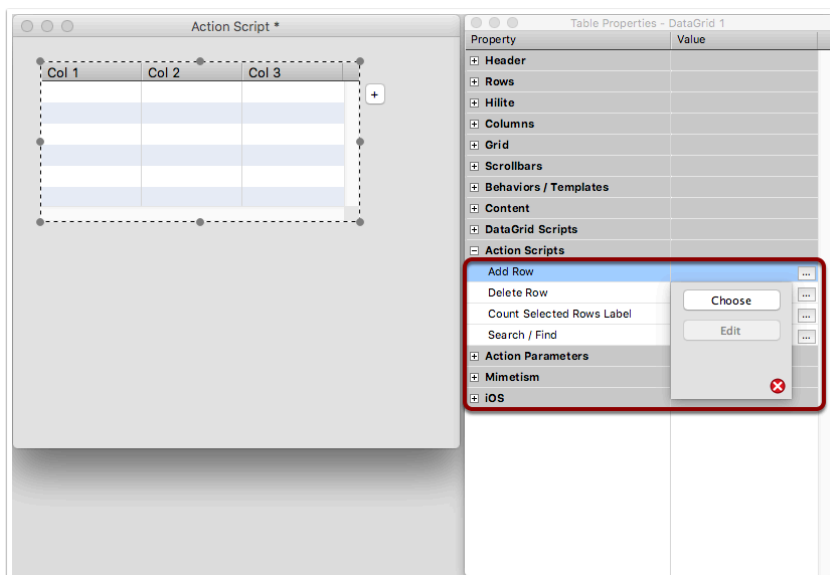
In this lesson we will see how to use DGH for selecting a button and associated it an action script which is creating a new row into the datagrid.



In this lesson, we are creating a stack containing a datagrid and a + button.

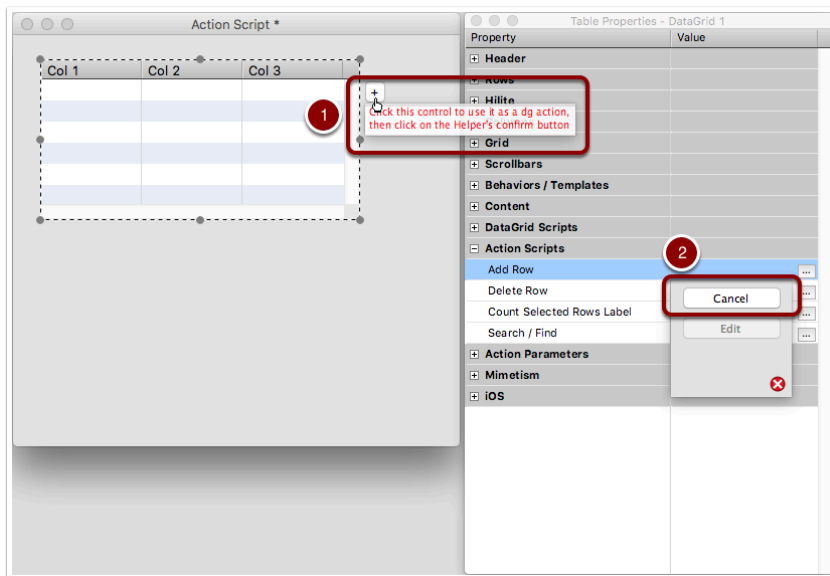
And we are opening DGH by double clicking onto the datagrid and then open the "Action scripts" topic.

Opening the Control Picker Window For Selecting A Button



For opening the control picker, click on the 3 dots button in regard to the Add Row line

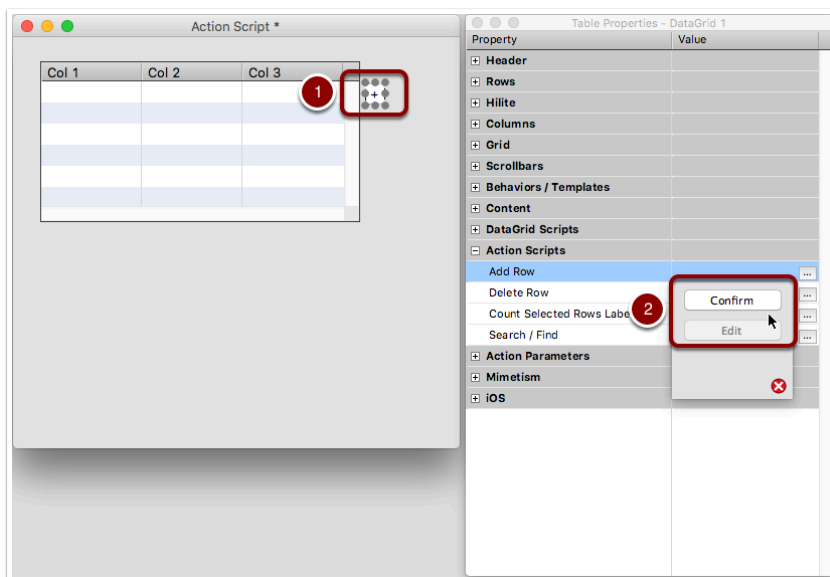
Moving the Mouse Over The + Button



Moving the mouse over the + button. DGH informs you the button is eligible by displaying an information tooltip. (1)

Note the state of the choose button which now displaying a cancel label. (2)

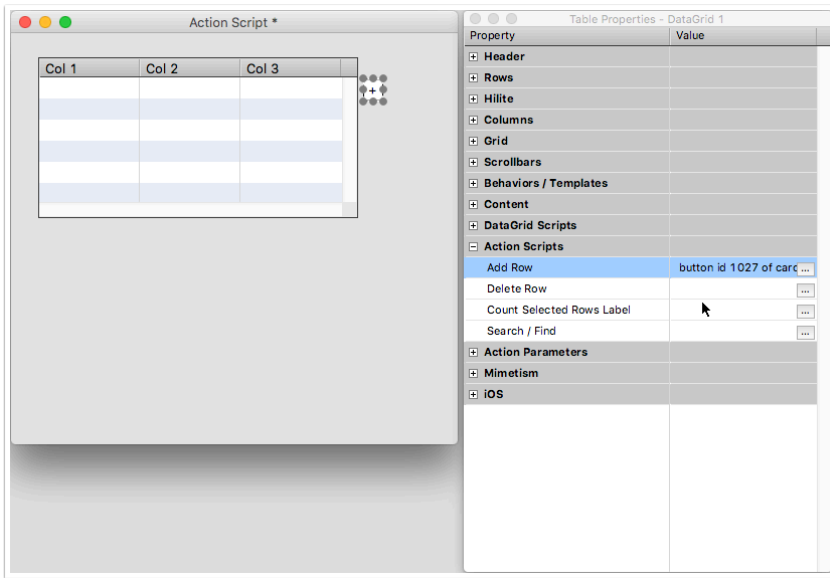
Selecting the + Button



Click onto the button to select it. This will cause, the picker window is now displaying a "Confirm" button. (1)

Then, click the "confirm" button to link the datagrid to the + button. (2)

The id of the button linked to DGH is now displayed inside the property for the "Add Row" line



Testing The + Button

We can now test the + button for adding a new row into the datagrid.
